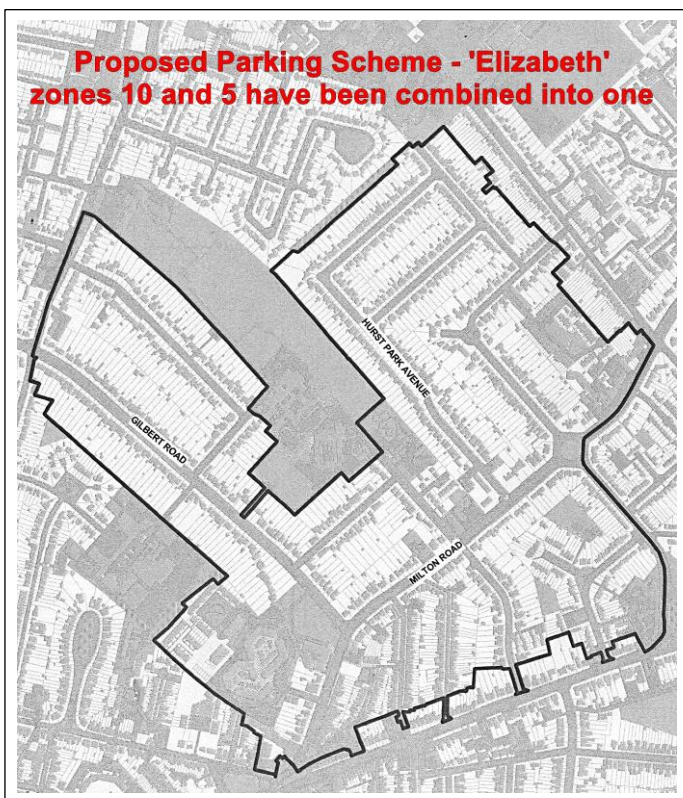


## Double Yellow Lines and Parking Bays could soon be coming to all our streets

At the recent meeting of the Cambridge North Area Committee we discovered that plans for residents' parking schemes are far more advanced than we had realised. We know that opinions differ concerning the need for such a scheme in our area and we were appalled that proper consultation directly with residents had not taken place.

We think it's important that everyone understands the full details of what is proposed and the likely consequences – elimination of commuter parking but also elimination and displacement of parking space for residents and their visitors, for example.

**Thurs 5<sup>th</sup> Oct 6.00pm–7.00pm.** A question & answer session about the process and any other matters.

**Wed 11<sup>th</sup> Oct and Wed 18<sup>th</sup> Oct 6.00-8.00pm.** Ian Manning will conduct workshops to consider modifying the plans and/or come up with alternatives.

Meet the officers with a final opportunity to put your views on **Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> November** – time and venue to be announced. As part of the statutory process a questionnaire will then be sent to all households in the Elizabeth zone. If 50% or more of respondents are in favour then the scheme will go ahead. **It's up to residents to decide.**

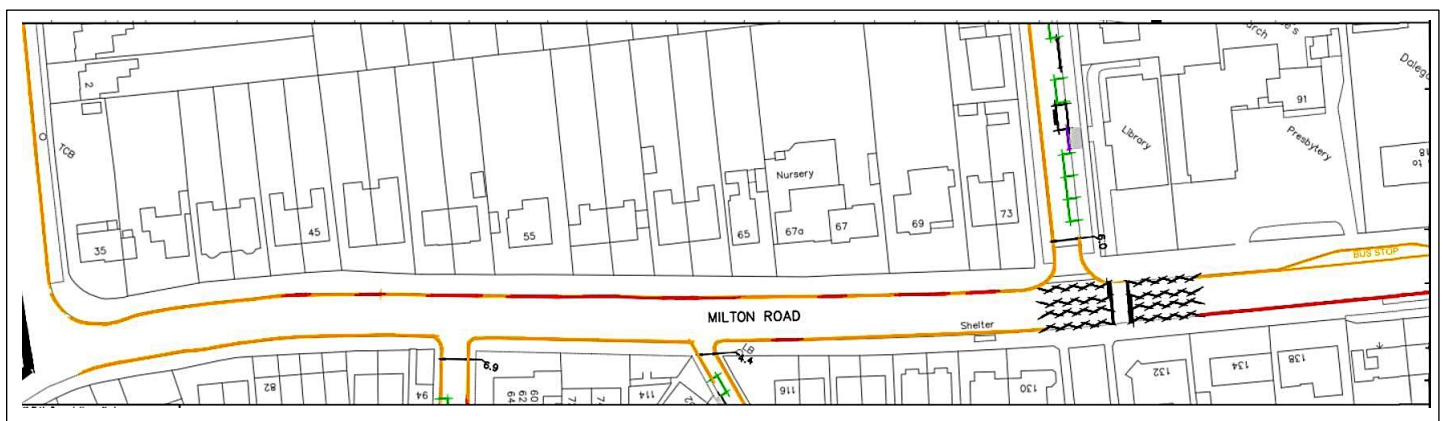
EXISTING DBL YELLOW

PARKING BAYS



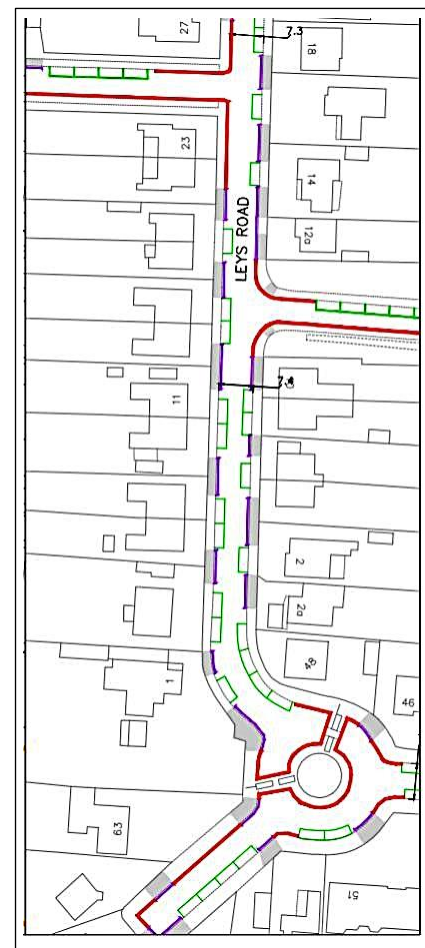
